

**Information Clause Regarding Collecting Identification Data
of Persons Who Remain on the Premises of Walcownia Metali “Dziedzice” S.A.**

1. The Data Controller is: Walcownia Metali „Dziedzice” S.A. with its registered office in Czechowice-Dziedzice (43-502), Poland, 3 Kaniowska St., NIP [*Tax Identification Number*]: 652-11-67-160, REGON [*National Official Business Register*] 273074410, KRS [*National Court Register*] 0000084770. 2. The purpose of the personal data processing is to identify and record the persons who remain at the Data Controller’s premises pursuant to Article 6 section 1(f) of the GDPR.
3. The personal data shall be retained for a period specified in the rules of law, including the Act on the protection of persons and property or until the end of the proceedings in the event that they are initiated.
4. The personal data is necessary to determine the identity of the visitors, to issue a pass, to provide access control to the premises and to assert claims related to, for instance, damage to property or theft.
5. You have the right to request access to your personal data, the right to rectify, delete the data after the lapse of the time periods for archiving or to restrict processing, as well as the right to object to processing to the Data Controller.
6. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
7. The recipients of personal data shall include entities authorised by law, data processors on the basis of concluded agreements on entrusting the processing of personal data.
8. The data is provided mandatorily. Failure to provide the data shall result in the lack of possibility to enter the Data Controller’s premises.
